RICK HENKEN

President and CEO of the Schochet Companies



Rick Henken joined the Schochet Companies as its Executive Vice President in 1997, after having been affiliated with and an advisor to the company for more than a decade. In 2004, Rick became President of the Schochet Companies including Schochet Development, Schochet Investments, and Schochet Property Management.

The Schochet Companies is a for-profit mission-driven developer, owner, and operator of multifamily housing throughout New England. Schochet's primary focus is the creation and preservation of affordable housing for vulnerable populations, including seniors and low-incomefamilies. Schochet's mission is to provide high quality service- enriched housing designed to help break the cycle of poverty and improve the quality of life for all the residents it serves.

Since joining the company Rick has been responsible for closing transactions with a total value in excess of \$1 billion, including the acquisition and preservation as affordable of over 3,500 apartments in almost two dozen developments.

Rick has sat on several Boards of Directors, including the Catholic Schools Foundation where he led as President from 2012-2015; the Greater Boston Real Estate Board (GBREB) where he served as Chairman; the Massachusetts Apartment Association (MAA) of GBREB where he served as President and chair of the Government Affairs Committee; the National Apartment Association where he served as a regional Vice President; and Jewish Family Services of MetroWest. Rick currently serves on the Boards of Hebrew Senior Life, where

he chairs its Senior Living Committee and is the Board Chair Elect; the Jonathan M. Tisch College of Citizenship and Public Service at Tufts University; B'nai B'rith Housing; NewLease for the Homeless; Discovering Justice; and the Catholic Schools Council. He is a member of the Economics Advisory Board of the Tufts Graduate School of Arts and Sciences.

Rick is the recipient of the 2011 Distinguished Service Award of the Tufts University Graduate School of Arts and Sciences; the 2012 recipient of the Retirement Housing Foundation Friend of the Elderly Award; the 2012 recipient of the B'nai B'rith Housing Distinguished Achievement Award; the RHA's 2017 Industry Excellence Award; and the 2020 Lawyers Clearinghouse Stephen M. Nolan Leadership Award.



Rick has generously supported the Catholic Schools Foundation for over 20 years through his philanthropic efforts. He is passionate about providing at-risk students with a high-quality Catholic education, based on Judeo-Christian values, and maximizing their chances of future success. Rick continues to serve on CSF's Gala Committee and Board Advancement.

Award-winning veteran journalist Ben Simmoneau is an anchor/reporter for WCVB's NewsCenter 5 at 4PM, 5PM, and

5:30PM. Ben also leads the station's nationally recognized consumer reporting franchise, "Ben Has Your Back." By confronting businesses, state agencies, and federal programs to get answers for Massachusetts residents who need a hand, Ben has helped hundreds of viewers recoup thousands of dollars that are rightfully theirs, while sharing lessons learned so that others can avoid similar pitfalls.

Joining WCVB Channel 5 marked a return to Hearst Television for Ben, who began his career at WGAL, the Hearst-owned NBC affiliate in Harrisburg-Lancaster, PA. Ben joined NewsCenter 5 from WNYW, the Fox flagship station in New York City where he worked as a weekday morning anchor since June 2013. Prior to joining Fox, Ben spent five years working as an anchor and investigative reporter for KYW, the CBS-owned television station in Philadelphia.

Ben received the first-place award for "On-Air Personality - Television" at the 2017 Sound Bites Awards presented by the Massachusetts Broadcasters Association. He is also a three-time Emmy winner who has also been honored twice with an Edward R. Murrow Award - once at WGAL for investigative reporting and once for his role as part of the team at KYW, which won for Station Excellence. Ben's innovative coverage of the 2006 midterm elections earned him a Walter Cronkite Award from the University of Southern California for excellence in political journalism.

Before graduating from Ithaca College with a journalism degree, Ben worked for Chris Matthews as a researcher on his bestselling book American: Beyond Our Grandest Notions.

In New York, Ben served on the Executive Council of the Crohn's and Colitis Foundation of America Greater New York Chapter. He now works actively with the New England Chapter, hosting the annual Take Steps walk fund raiser and the organization's largest annual event, the Fete of Food and Wine. He has also worked in the past with the Children's Miracle Network and Alex's Lemonade Stand Foundation.

An avid runner, Ben also enjoys reading, traveling, and spending time with his wife and two children.
