ABOUT HONOREE PETER S. LYNCH

Vice Chairman, Fidelity Management and Research Company

PETER S. LYNCH is considered one of the most successful money managers in Wall Street history. He ran Fidelity's Magellan Fund from May 1977 to May 1990.

During his tenure, an investment of \$1,000 in the fund starting in 1977 was worth \$28,000 by the time he stepped down in 1990. For the thirteen years he ran the fund, it was the #1 fund in the world. In addition, by 1983 Magellan had become the largest fund, and for the subsequent seven years Lynch managed it, Magellan outperformed all other mutual funds. One out of every hundred Americans shared in these results.

Lynch is the author of three books, One Up on Wall Street, Beating the Street, and Learn to Earn. His

works have been touted as some of the most successful books ever written about the stock market and investing. They have been translated into over twenty different languages and continue to be read all over the world.

He stopped running the Magellan Fund in 1990 to devote more time to non-profit work and to increase time spent with his wife, Carolyn, and three daughters. Today, Lynch serves on several boards of charities and as president of the family's Lynch Foundation. For over thirty years, he has devoted half his workweek to help raise scholarships for needy young students of all faiths and nationalities who live in the inner city of Boston and attend Catholic schools. This effort is called the **Building Minds Scholarship Fund**, and Lynch has helped raise more than \$350 million, with \$7 million or more in partial scholarships being awarded to needy children every year.

In addition to devoting his time to philanthropic work, profits from his three books and honorarium fees from speaking engagements have also been donated to charity.

Peter Lynch continues to serve as an Advisory Board Member for the Fidelity Funds, and he is the Vice Chairman of Fidelity Management & Research Company. He enjoys working with new analysts at Fidelity, meeting with them several times throughout the year.

BEN SIMMONEAU ANCHOR, WCVB CHANNEL 5

Award-winning veteran journalist Ben Simmoneau is an anchor/reporter for WCVB's NewsCenter 5 at 4PM, 5PM, and 5:30PM. Ben also leads the station's nationally recognized consumer reporting franchise, "Ben Has Your Back." By confronting businesses, state agencies, and federal programs to get answers for Massachusetts residents who need a hand, Ben has helped hundreds of viewers recoup thousands of dollars that are rightfully theirs, while sharing lessons learned so that others can avoid similar pitfalls.

Joining WCVB Channel 5 marked a return to Hearst Television for Ben, who began his career at WGAL,

the Hearst-owned NBC affiliate in Harrisburg-Lancaster, PA. Ben joined NewsCenter 5 from WNYW, the Fox flagship station in New York City where he worked as a weekday morning anchor since June 2013. Prior to joining Fox, Ben spent five years working as an anchor and investigative reporter for KYW, the CBS-owned television station in Philadelphia.

Ben received the first-place award for "On-Air Personality — Television" at the 2017 Sound Bites Awards presented by the Massachusetts Broadcasters Association. He is also a three-time Emmy winner who has also been honored twice with an Edward R. Murrow Award — once at WGAL for investigative reporting and once for his role as part of the team at KYW, which won for Station Excellence. Ben's innovative coverage of the 2006 midterm elections earned him a Walter Cronkite Award from the University of Southern California for excellence in political journalism.

Before graduating from Ithaca College with a journalism degree, Ben worked for Chris Matthews as a researcher on his bestselling book American: Beyond Our Grandest Notions.

In New York, Ben served on the Executive Council of the Crohn's and Colitis Foundation of America Greater New York Chapter. He now works actively with the New England Chapter, hosting the annual Take Steps walk fundraiser and the organization's largest annual event, the Fete of Food and Wine. He has also worked in the past with the Children's Miracle Network and Alex's Lemonade Stand Foundation.

An avid runner, Ben also enjoys reading, traveling, and spending time with his wife and two children.
