



## Board Training Program

### Background

The Catholic Schools Foundation (CSF) Board of Trustees voted to approve funding for strategic investments in school leadership in collaboration with the Catholic Schools Office (CSO) as part of a multi-year investment to increase effectiveness of Catholic school leaders.

In order to support Catholic school leaders and good governance, CSF and the CSO are building a pool of qualified, committed, and trained individuals to actively serve as board members at in-need Catholic schools in the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Boston (RCAB).

### Process

Through the Catholic School Board Training Program, the CSF and the CSO are developing a replicable program for board member training that promotes best practices for good governance and matches program graduates with in-need Catholic school boards.

### Audience

Individuals seeking to bring their diverse occupational backgrounds and experiences to serve on Catholic school boards, including ICSF Young Leaders, Boston Advocates for Catholic Education (BACE), and other ICSF supporters
