



CSF Scholarship Fund Definitions

Each school should have three funds for CSF scholarships: General, Retention, and Recruitment. The total of the Retention fund and the total of the Recruitment fund cannot exceed the school's total FY19 Retention and Recruitment grant. Only schools with Hispanic Recruitment Initiative/New Immigrant Scholarship (HRI/NIS) students and grants need to create an HRI/NIS Returning fund and/or HRI/NIS New fund.

General Fund: is for returning, qualifying students who received General, Retention or Recruitment scholarships in the 2017-2018 school year.

- The scholarship amounts cannot change.
- FY19 Retention and Recruitment scholarships become General scholarships in FY19.
- If a student received a General scholarship AND a Retention scholarship in FY18, the General scholarship for FY19 is the sum of these two awards.
- If a student withdraws from the school or does not re-qualify for aid, the school cannot re-assign the award in any fund.

Retention Fund: is for returning students who did not receive a scholarship the previous year OR students in General or HRI/NIS funds who require additional scholarship support.

Recruitment Fund: is for students who are new to the school.

HRI/NIS Returning Fund: is for qualifying students who received HRI/NIS scholarships in the 2017-2018 school year.

- The scholarship amounts cannot change for returning students.

HRI/NIS New Fund: is for students who are new to the school recruited through additional FY19 HRI/NIS funds.
