Dear High School Partners,

On behalf of the Allocations Committee of the Board of Trustees of the Catholic Schools Foundation (CSF), I am pleased to share with you the names of students who will receive scholarship funding as CSF Scholars at any RCAB Catholic High School beginning in the 2019-2020 school year.

These students were selected to receive CSF scholarship support through our CSF Scholars Guaranteeing Opportunities (GO) Program or our Continuum Pilot Program. Scholarships are guaranteed at the same level each year the students are enrolled at the same RCAB Catholic high school provided the students meet all CSF Scholar grant criteria and all reporting requests. If a student withdraws from the school, the award is no longer available to the student nor the school.

These awards are distributed to high schools and are independent of, and in addition to, any funding or applications currently pending or approved, including the regular CSF Scholars Class of 2023 grant process. High schools may assign additional funding to the selected students from other funds or other eligible CSF grants received by the school (i.e. regular CSF Scholars Class of 2023 grant process).

Students must be accepted through schools' regular admissions process.

This scholarship funding is designed to strengthen a K-12 Catholic school continuum and create access for the most in-need students to attend a high-quality Catholic high school. Catholic Schools Foundation strongly encourages high schools to partner with the students listed, their families and schools through the enrollment and financial aid processes to make the opportunity for a Catholic high school education a reality for the students. We kindly ask high schools to help enrolled scholars navigate CSF expectations and opportunities.
