The Catholic Schools Foundation (CSF) is pleased to announce its partnership again with the Woods College of Advancing Studies at Boston College for the Boston College Experience Program. Both CSF and BC are committed to providing students who might not have the financial resources the opportunity to attend the [Boston College Experience](#) summer program. **Eight full-tuition scholarships for rising junior and senior CSF Scholarship recipients will be provided for a 3-week residential program.** Students will be responsible for providing their own spending money.

This scholarship is for a 3-week residential program **at Boston College** for **rising juniors and seniors** in high school that allows students to experience firsthand university-level academics and college life. Read the full description of this non-credit program [here](#).

How to Apply:

*Please note – Although BC program is available to rising sophomores, juniors and seniors, the CSF scholarship is open to **only** rising juniors and seniors. Students should remember they are applying for the 3-week residential program and review the course selections available.*

- Application, letter of recommendation, and personal essay for the CSF scholarship are due **April 15, 2019**.
- Applications must be completed and submitted online. The link for the online application found [here](#).
- The application fee will be waived for students applying through CSF.
- **To identify themselves as applicants for the scholarship, students should answer “yes” to the question: “Are you eligible for a scholarship?” Students will then select Catholic Schools Foundation Scholarship from the drop down menu.**
