As part of the scholarship agreement, we are requesting the following resources to be sent by **June 30, 2020** to **zcreeden@csfboston.org**:

- Student year end transcript
- Updated student activity report (clubs, extracurricular activities, sports, volunteering, campus ministry, honors or awards)
- Narrative summary of student successes (500 words) from his or her guidance counselor
- School photo
- Personal letter from the GO Scholar to the supporting donor (**please edit for content and grammar with students before sending**). If your GO scholar was NOT assigned a specific donor the student **does not** have to complete a letter. For any inquiries please contact Zach Creeden, Annual Fund and Partnerships Coordinator at zcreeden@csfboston.org. (During the COVID-19, the CSF staff is working remotely and we ask that all letters be sent electronically to Zach's email address).

The personal letter should include a thank you message to the GO scholar donor for the scholarship and answer any 6 of the following questions:

1. What about thinking, learning, or work this year brought you the most satisfaction? Why?
2. What was your greatest challenge this year? How did you overcome this challenge? What lesson did you learn from it?
3. What was the most important book you have had to read for high school so far and why?
4. Which of your classes are the most interesting and why?
5. What are the extracurricular activities and sports you participated in this year? What do you like about these activities?
6. What are your goals for next school year?
7. What strengths do you bring to the classroom?
8. What is your biggest dream in life and what do you feel you have to do to achieve it?
9. What do you like about attending a Catholic school?
